• <u>Financial Review</u> — Michele Kersey Smith stated that she didn't see anything alarming but asked Ryan to explain the high percentage on the professional development and textbooks. Because the services hadn't been rendered by the end of the last year, it was accrued but whatever funds that were left from last year will be rolled over. The textbooks are split between electronic textbooks and physical textbooks but between the two it averages out. The audit is in the final stages and we should see their final statement very soon. The school received more federal money this last year, so it required a single audit of federal funds. Ryan will be working with Dave and the lunch manager on this.
